Dear Wife

I arrived all right am staying here for the present but dont think I shall stay here long. I want to get a cheaper place I did not find Pratt here as I expected. have not seen him yet. have been associating with Mr Tencher since I have been here went to the Theatre with him and Mr William Sperry last night we are as thick as two Chinamen what do you think of that. I am feeling first rate this morning I do wish Emma Jane was here. if she had some one to look after her. I do believe this climate would

make a change in her.
I would willinly pay any
ones expences that will bring
her and take care of her a week
or so.

if Mrs Abbott or any one
else will come with her let
them come at once to the
Morton House

for myself I shall
get cheaper lodgings tomorrow
I am going to try and find
Frank tomorrow will write
again soon to let you know
how I am getting along. direct
