private conveyance home on Saturday
I shall stay in Paris Tuesday night in Keene Wednesday
Montpelier Thursday night & Friday I know not
where I will get some New Sugar all scrip
off for me I will have good lick
the Whigs go it here straight through
they call me on but I am a true
Dem I will bring if I can some
Whig papers (I shall get old
tips (Harrison) for President)
Remember me to all friends
I must not stop to write any more
Must get a Trial Balance on my Books
thru well E. Y. in haste
