

Valley Spring
Feb 15 1893

My dear Boy,

Your long looked for letter came at last! And I can not tell you how glad I was to hear from you once more And that you was well and also that your Mother was a great deal better I hope she will keep on improving

You said you had a small flood dam there but I think by the way

the ~~paper~~ paper reads
that there was a bigger
flood than I would
have wanted to see

Well we are having the
sun shine up here and
I suppose you have it
down there

And you said that when
the weather settled that
you would come up here

Well ever since I got
your letter I have been
praying for it to clear
off and you know that
when a good little girl
like me gets to praying
they are sure to be answered
The river is so it can be
crossed now so I will
look for you any day

after you get this letter
and be sure and dont
disappoint me For if it
dont rain any more
before you come the river
will be run down considerable
John crossed it last
Monday

If Alice thinks you are
so much trouble I would
like her to have John down
there for a day or so
and see what she would
think of him

He has been working
around the house this
week and Flora and I
have not had any
rest from morning till
night For you know the
old saying when the

eat. away the mice will
play. Flora and I are going
up to see Emma to morrow
and the men folks will have
to get their own dinner and
they dont like that a bit
